How-To Photos.... Carp Fishing Isn't Rocket Science!

One of the great things about carp fishing is it's not high-tech!

Here are some photos that illustrate some of the proven

techniques in the article.



A simple carp rig: 1-ounce sliding egg sinker, a swivel as a sinker stop and a 12 inch leader to a hook.



Transferring canned sweet corn kernels from a baiting needle to a hair rig.

Hair rig: the loop of braided line attached to the hook holds the bait.



Using a fishing rod with this spod device attached to the line, chum is delivered to the exact area of your hook bait. The spod cup has Styrofoam in the bottom so it tips upside down upon hitting the water.



With bait out, rods in the pod and bite detectors set, it is time to kick back and wait for a bite.
