Recipes for Carp Bait

All ingredients are available in the grocery store.

Jerry Fardoe's Boilie Recipe

10 cloves of garlic or 1 tsp. garlic powder

4 jumbo eggs (beaten)

3 tsp. honey

1 tsp. olive oil

25 ounces of flour

1 100g tin of kippers (herring)

Blend garlic, honey and kippers in a food processor; add beaten eggs and flour to form dough. Refrigerate for one hour. Hand-roll the dough into small balls and boil for two minutes, then air-dry overnight. Refrigerate until you leave for your fishing outing. Use a baiting needle to thread a boilie onto a hair rig.

Dale Black's Strawberry Dough

- 1 cup sugar
- 2 cups white flour
- 3 cups cornmeal
- 1 package of strawberry Jello-O

Mix dry ingredients in a bowl. Slowly add water and mix to desired consistency. Flatten the ball, wrap in cloth bag, and place in boiling water for 20 minutes. Cool the ball of dough then put in a plastic bag and refrigerate. When the mixture cools enough to handle, knead a package of powdered strawberry Jell-O into the dough. Break off a small amount and form a ball around the hook.
